Renewal of Registration Audit

I am writing to you in relation to the audit of the application for renewal of TAT (Security / Taxi Training) Pty Ltd registration as a Registered Training Organisation (RTO) pursuant to Part 4.3 of the *Education and Training Reform Act 2006*.

It is a condition of the *Education and Training Reform Act 2006* that a RTO must comply with the minimum conditions and standards and any guidelines for registration including the *Australian Quality Training Framework Essential Conditions and Standards for Continuing Registration (AQTF)* and the *VRQA Guidelines for VET Providers (VRQA Guidelines)*.

An independent audit on 24 and 25 of September 2014 assessed the compliance of TAT (Security / Taxi Training) Pty Ltd against these standards for the purpose of renewal of registration. I note that you accepted the findings of the **AQTF** and **VRQA Guidelines** audit report in full and have provided comments on the draft audit report which was provided to you by the auditor.

I enclose a copy of the final audit report for your attention. The audit report indicates minor non-compliance with the **AQTF**.

You are required under section 4.3.17(2)(C) (ii) of the *Education and Training Reform Act 2006* to take the necessary steps to address all non-compliances.

On the basis of the findings I have decided to renew the registration of TAT (Security / Taxi Training) Pty Ltd as a registered training organisation until **31 October 2019**. However, I would like to reinforce that TAT (Security / Taxi Training) Pty Ltd ensure that trainers and assessors for the HLTAID003 *Provide first aid* and HLTAID001 *Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation* have sufficient and current vocational experience in the practice of administering first aid.

Please be advised that the Victorian Registration and Qualifications Authority (VRQA) is satisfied that your organisation meets the minimum principal purpose requirements and the financial viability requirements in compliance with ETR Act.

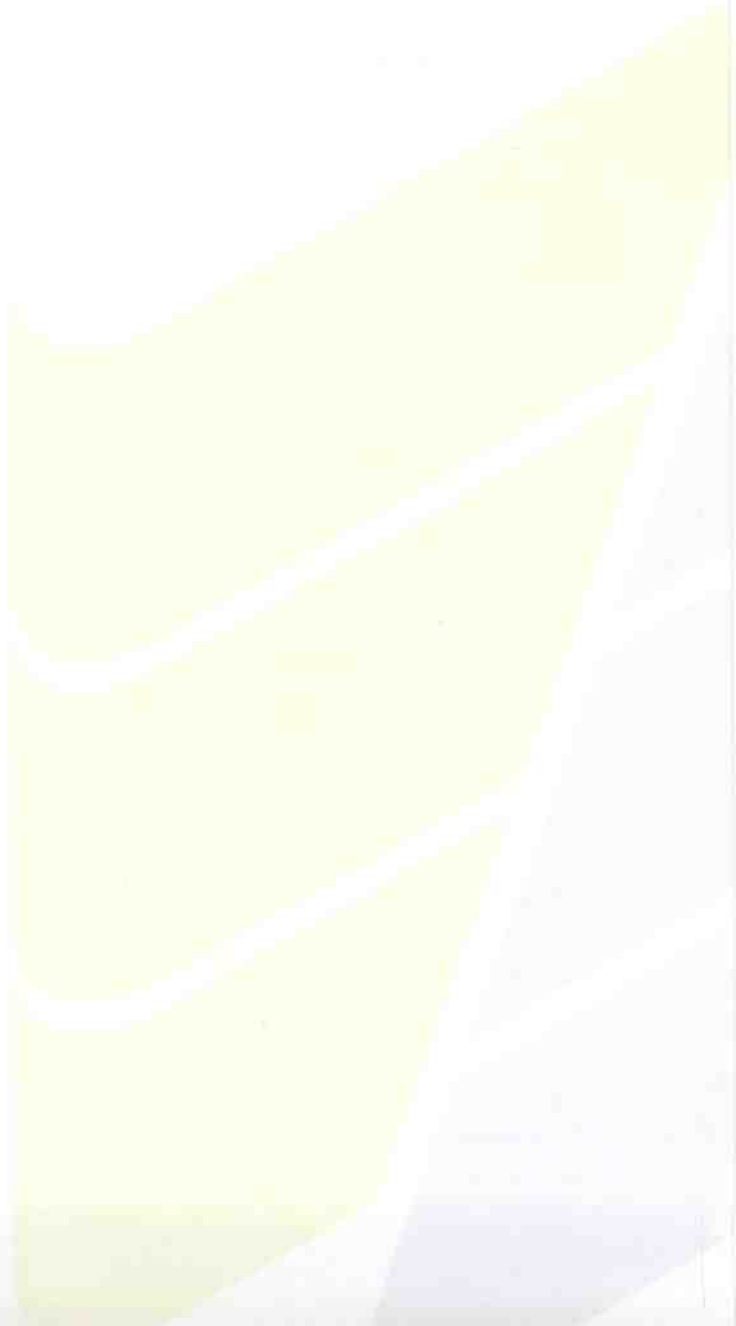
