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Course Aims & Objectives

This qualification enables students to acquire the skills and knowledge required to provide a first aid response to infants, children and adults. The unit applies to educators and support staff working within an education and care setting who are required to respond to a first aid emergency, including asthmatic and anaphylactic emergencies.

Entry Requirements & Prerequisites

You will be required to go through the institutes Pre-Training Review Process; this will include completing a Language, Literacy and Numeracy Appraisal. This is to ensure you have the skills required to successfully complete this training.

Upon completing the Pre-Training Review, you will be required to complete an "Application for Enrolment" form to process your enrolment confirmation.

Refreshers

Current industry standards state this course must be updated every three (3) years with the CPR component being updated every twelve (12) months. However it is advised, specific requirements, including requirements for refresher training, should be obtained from the Australian Children's Education and Care Quality Authority (ACECQA) and/or relevant state/territory Work Health and Safety Regulatory Authority.

Completion Requirements

To achieve the qualification applicants must have demonstrated competency against the following performance elements:

- Respond to an emergency situation
- Legal and other issues
- Debriefing / Welfare
- Basic Life Support
- Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation

- Automatic External Defibrillator
- Airway Management / Choking
- Bandaging (Knots, Slings, Fractures)
- Eye and Ear injuries
- Head injuries
- Burns and scalds
- Managing serious bleeding
- Asthma Management
- Shock Management
- Airway Management / Choking
- Restraint Asphyxia
- Musculoskeletal injuries
- Needle stick injuries
- Environmental conditions
- Envenomation
- Poisons
- Epilepsy
- Epi Pen / Anaphylaxis
- Diabetes
- Seizures
- Communicate details of the incident
- Evaluate the incident and own performance

It is a requirement of this course that practical demonstration of CPR must be performed on the floor.

Assessment and Duration

Students will be required to be assessed in this program, to show that they have achieved the skills and knowledge set out in the competency standards.

Assessment may include a variety of approaches, for example, practical demonstration, open book questions, case studies and incident reports. Course Duration is 2 days face to face delivery from 8.30am to 4.30pm.

Resources & Facilities

Prospective emergency response students will be provided with all required resources and equipments. Classes will be conducted as required in an appropriate learning environment.

Course Fees & Charges

The course will cost \$220.00. A minimum payment of \$150.00 is required prior to course commencement for administration and enrolment fee. All cancellation requests

made prior to course commencement date will incur a \$150.00 administration and enrolment fee. Once courses have commenced, the organization will not approve refunds or transfers under any circumstances.

Technical Advanced Training reserves the rights to cancel or postpone the course commencement date with low enrolment numbers up to two days prior to the course commencement date.
